Our definition of 'led by and for'

'Led by and for' organisations are those run, designed and delivered by and for people who are from marginalised and minoritised communities that face additional forms of discrimination, and structural and systemic inequality. These include communities such as LGBT+ people, d/Deaf and disabled people and those from racially minoritised communities.



Eligibility Criteria

- Led by and for
- A specialist domestic abuse service
- A registered not-for-profit organisation with a charitable purpose including CICs
- Must have published your first annual accounts
- Have a safeguarding policy
- Primarily operates in the UK

Programme Fit

1

Strong track record

- three years' experience
- a clear understanding of intersecting needs
- staff with relevant expertise and experience

2

In-depth and consistent

- A trusted source of ongoing support responding to changing needs
- We won't fund organisations that only provide short-term interventions

3

Person-centred

- 1:1 support, such as casework
- Support developed with the individual
- We won't fund organisations that only offer group-based support

4

Holistic

- Wrap-around support that addresses a range of needs via several services
- Work in partnership where you are unable to meet a need
