## What is the Shout! Fund?

The Shout! Fund supports advocacy services that help young people speak up, make informed choices, and secure their rights.



# Our key features of advocacy



## Independent

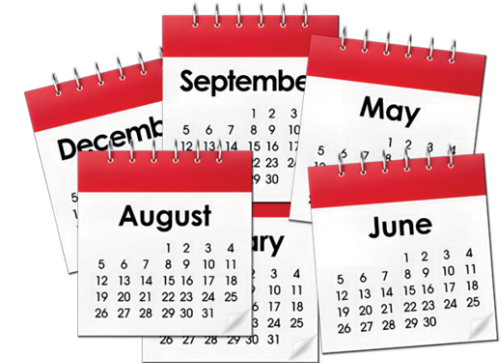
The service is not tied to state care or treatment provision or to a particular authority. Staff can act in the young person's best interests and represent their wishes without conflict.



## Rights-based

Enabling young people to:

- Understand their options
- Navigate services
- Be a part of decisions about their life
- Challenge unfair treatment
- Speak up about what matters to them



## Not time limited

Whether in one-to-one or group settings, your service provides opportunities for regular engagement over time, allowing young people to build trusting relationships.



## Who the fund is for

To apply to the Shout Fund! your organisation must support at least one of these groups:

- Young people with care experience
- Young people who identify as LGBT+
- Young people who have learning disabilities or who are neurodivergent

You can work with more than one group. However, you must show your understanding of these groups in your application.
