What is the Proud Homes fund?

The Proud Homes fund supports generalist homelessness organisations to embed safe, culturally competent and affirming practice for LGBT+ young people.





Who is this fund for?

Organisations that:

- Deliver generalist homelessness support (e.g. housing advice, hostels, supported accommodation, outreach or prevention services etc.)
- Have a demonstrable track record of working with young people.
- Demonstrate a commitment to embedding inclusive practice throughout.
- Show an understanding of why LGBT+ young people are at heightened risk within homelessness systems
- Meaningfully involve people with lived experience and youth voice in shaping services and making decisions.
- Have services that support young people aged approx. 16-25.
